<u>VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS</u>	<u>CHARGES</u>	<u>PERSONAL ITEMS</u>
<p>In accordance with the Department of Education and Training's Contributions, Charges and Fees Policy September 2001, schools can request up to a maximum contribution of \$60 for years K-6.</p> <p>A Contribution is 'voluntary' and the funds are used towards the cost of materials, services and facilities used by students in the educational program.</p> <p>Contributions collected at this school contribute to: Classroom resources, e.g. computer equipment, textbooks and workbooks, and art equipment.</p>	<p>The term 'charges' refers to the provision of extra cost optional activities which form part of an education program and which voluntary contributions do not cover. All the following are optional and if no payment is received, an educational activity with a similar outcome will be provided to that student.</p> <p>The 2025 extra cost optional activities, which have been approved by the School Council, are as follows. The estimated costs provided are at an upper limit and will not exceed this amount. If a particular event does not transpire within the school year no charges for that event will apply. The School Council has approved all charges.</p>	<p>These items (as per attached list) have been approved by the School Council as being recommended by students for personal use in the educational programs provided by this school. Our list is from Campion however, <b>parents can purchase items from any supplier of their choice.</b></p>
