COVID UPDATE

As you are aware the Premier has extended **Phase 4 until Friday 23 October**. While parents are permitted on-site we are required to ensure we continue to maintain the physical distancing rule for adults and greatly appreciate the enormous and positive support we have had from our community in helping us keep everyone safe.

We are anticipating our school's new website will be launched at the beginning of next term. The website's build is underway, incorporating some fabulous updated professional photography and all updated information relating to our school.

We are planning for the website to be the primary information gateway for Belmay Primary School and will survey our community for feedback towards the end of the year in order to ensure that we are targeting our families expectations and needs.

UPGRADES TO WA SCHOOLS

The Governments new 'WA Recovery Plan' will deliver "unprecedented investment" in local infrastructure, community facilities, and job creation. The plan will create short and long-term jobs to assist the construction, manufacturing, tourism, hospitality, renewable energy, training, education, and agriculture industries.

Among the many funding initiatives announced over the past week, the government plans to allocate funding to Belmay Primary School for upgrading and refurbishment. This is a very exciting development for our school. Terry Harney and I have already had a preliminary meeting with the project officers assigned to our school to discuss future works. We look forward to sharing these plans more fully with the school community next term.
